CHAIRMAN'S REPORT 2016

This has undoubtedly been a fantastic year for the Club and the main points to note are:

- The highest membership total in recent years 193 members (108 Sen, 80 Jun, 5 Hon)
- A junior section that continues to shine in the local, district and national arena.
- A senior section with an ever-increasing nucleus of male and female runners training on Monday and Wednesday evenings as well as more runs being organised between members at other times during the week.
- Numerous team and individual prizewinners at Road, XC, Track and Field and Hill Running events
- The continued hosting of popular race fixtures ND X-Country Champs, Miltonduff 10k, Lossie Turkey Trot and Kinloss to Lossie Half Marathon.
- Healthy income that has allowed the Club to continue paying SAL membership for all its senior members and competing juniors as well as helping to subsidise transport to fixtures.
- The Club has been at the forefront of the Elgin Parkrun, initially in terms of financial assistance, administration and guidance but now, importantly, helping with its sustainability through willing volunteers on a weekly basis.
- The Club has representation on both the Cooper Park Community Sports Hub Committee and a Moray Athletics Forum looking at improved facilities as part of the proposed Moray Sports Centre.
- Most importantly, a spirit and camaraderie at the Club that is apparent at training, races and competitive fixtures.

Looking to the next 12 months, MRR will continue to organise various races throughout the year to provide opportunities for our own athletes and others to compete locally as well as raising funds for the Club. The Club will also continue to promote participation at local events, league fixtures, district and national championships – 14 teams at the recent ND XC Relays was fantastic to see and hopefully this momentum will continue into 2017 and beyond. However, we need to increase the number of coaches and volunteers if the Club is to continue to prosper and members are to realise their full potential. Therefore, it is hoped that more people will take an active interest in developing all aspects of the Club. That said, the Club, arguably, is as strong as it has ever been – membership is buoyant, participation in races is increasing, performances are improving, we are financially sound and we have a fantastic reputation within the local community. I have no doubt whatsoever that Moray Road Runners will go from strength to strength in 2017 and remain a Community Club to be proud of.

MRR TREASURER'S REPORT FOR 2015 6

The new strength of the balance sheet reflects the vitality of the Club over the last 12 months. Membership numbers and race entries for Club run events have increased substantially to give record levels of income. The Committee has worked hard at the same time to keep under review expenditure with a particular focus being on the twin headings of race costs and transport charges.

Looking ahead the financial strength of the Club will help give continued support to individual club members whether for by example be it payment of cross country entries or through provision of training opportunities. There are plans to focus upon the further promotion of Club activities. Small increases in the entry fees for our flagship MRR races are planned for the new season.

Club finances continue to be monitored by the Committee and a further important safeguard is the annual audit process. Once again our thanks go to Mary Bain who has undertaken this important activity for the Club.
